


## SHIMUNGWE LODGE

### **General Information**

- Check in 14hoo / check out 11hoo
  - Included in your stay: all meals, two daily game drives, bottled water, tea and coffee and Wi-Fi in the main areas of the lodge
  - Excluded: Beverages, telephone calls, laundry, gratuities, levies, any additional costs incurred or not specified
- All major credit cards accepted except for American Express
- Children of all ages are welcome
- Children under the age of 6 are not permitted on game drive
- Children under the age of 16 are not permitted on bush walks
- Excursions (Hot Air Ballooning / Endangered Centre) may be booked on your behalf at an additional cost
- → Beverages, gratuities, levies, any additional activities are not included
- Guests will be required to complete and sign an indemnity form



# A Typical Day on Safari



- $\rightarrow$  A typical day in the bush starts off with a wake up call at around o5h3o am, depending on the time of year.
- A delicious cup of coffee or tea awaits you on the deck of the main lodge area before you depart on your game drive.
- → The excitement of tracking down the early animal risers is briefly interrupted by a sunrise stop, breaking for coffee / tea and a light snack before continuing your adventure. You will return to the lodge at around o9hoo to freshen up before enjoying a tasty brunch with a choice of continental and hot breakfast.
- → Afternoon high tea is served at around 15h30 with a selection of sweet and savory treats.
  The afternoon game drive departs shortly thereafter in search of the Big-5. A sunset stop for a refreshing drink allows for spectacular photographic opportunities of the setting African Sun (weather permitting). The search for nocturnal creatures continues into the early evening before returning to the lodge at around 19h30.
- → Upon your return, a welcome drink will await your arrival. Thereafter you may either choose to freshen up or make your way to the bar area for a drink before enjoying dinner beautifully laid out under the African Canvas of stars.
